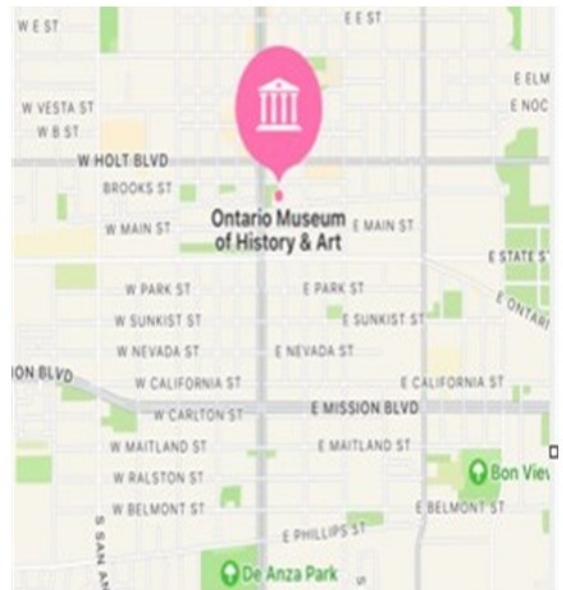

Gerhard Richter is considered one of the most important contemporary living German artists. Born 90 years ago in Dresden, he paints photo based bright color abstractions. He created 1,671 paintings after a major stroke. Here are his self professed art rules:

1. Maintain a strict 9-5pm routine.
2. Have someone else 'take out the laundry'.
3. Work in a studio that is distraction free.
4. Display your art in your studio so that it mimics a gallery.
5. Hang out with your art heroes.
6. The studio should be a storehouse of treasures.
7. Cultivate extreme narcissism.
8. Ignore both praise and criticism.
9. A good painting is the best reward.
