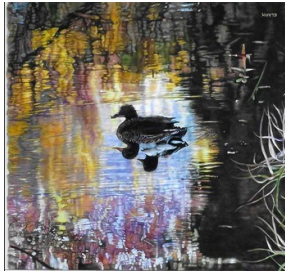

## Artist Call Ontario Arts Festival – October 21, 2023

The **Ontario Arts Festival** is seeking independent artists for this year's annual event, which will be held October 21, 2023 from 10am – 5pm. Artists residing in California, particularly the Inland Empire region, are strongly encouraged to apply. To be considered for this year's festival, begin your application via [Submittable](#). Each artist application, once accepted into the festival, will pay a \$75 fee for a 10' x 10' canopy, one 6-foot table, two chairs, and table linens (if needed).

The festival features a wide range of artists and mediums, including but not limited to: fine art, textiles, ceramics, digital art, photography, jewelry, metal, wood and more.

All applicants are reviewed by a volunteer jury made up of museum organizations, artists, and local residents.

We are pleased to introduce a **BEST IN SHOW award** that will be selected and designated on the day of the festival. The winning artist will receive \$500 and bragging rights!

**Applications must be submitted by June 30, 2023 (5 pm PST).**
