## Philip Latimer Dike

#### The San Antonio Collection - Early California Watercolors and More

CCMA presents a collection of early watercolor paintings, oil painting and serigraphs by Phil Dike (1906-1990), known to many in the Pomona Valley art community as a leading innovator of the California Style watercolor painting movement prevalent in the 1940s, 1950s and 1960s. All the works of art in this exhibition were completed during this mid-century period, and all were personally donated by Mr. Dike to San Antonio Community Hospital where he served as an art coordinator and consultant.

The artist reception includes a presentation at 2:15 pm by Woody Dike, son of the artist. He will discuss his father's relationship with San Antonio Community Hospital and Dr. Al Aita, who conceived of the idea of using fine art as healing.
