














AAIE was honored to have the talented Sherif sharing a wealth of information of his charcoal techniques during his demo of white on Art Black Sanded Paper (deep black). With a very minimal use of implements, but each one equally important, Sherif creates hyper realistic animals who seem to come alive. His white charcoal pencil (558) is by General, and he sharpens it by hand. Two soft brushes are used, if needed, to blend out harsh scratches on paper for an illusion of soft fur, which contrasts the foreground and background of some of his animals. A proportional divider, along with the grid method, is one of his finest tools to obtain the accurate sizes of his images. Once the dimensions are correct, painterly freedom is used at his discretion to brush, dab, soften, or sharpen the

smallest muzzle hairs of the animal. Mixing various brush stroke details and values is

> essential in adding to his masterly touch. Each drawing is finished with a Dewitt Fixative spray.




