CCMA 2023 Members Exhibit *IMPACT*

November 18, 2023 - January 20, 2024

The Chaffey Community Museum of Art invites its members to participate in *IMPACT*, the 2023 CCMA Members Exhibition.

Eligibility: All participants must be current CCMA members. If you are not currently a member, you may join prior to take-in and be eligible to participate in *IMPACT*. To check on membership status, email courtneysaldana@chaffeymuseum.org.

Art styles, themes & fees: All styles and themes of art are welcome. For 2023 *IMPACT*, members are limited to one FREE submission.

Take-in/pick-up dates:

Take-in: Saturday, November 11, 2023, 1 to 3 p.m. or Sunday, November 12, 1 to 3 p.m.

Pick-up: Sunday, January 21, 2024, 1 to 3 p.m.

*If you are unable to come on the above dates to drop off or pick up your work, please call the museum at 909-463-3733 or email info@chaffeymuseum.org to make an appointment during regular museum hours.

Exhibit dates & artist reception: The exhibit will be on view from November 17, 2023, to January 20, 2024. The Artist Reception/Champagne & Chocolates will be on Sunday, December 10, 2023, from 4 to 6 p.m.

Submission rules:

1. All artwork must be original, produced within the previous 12 months, and not previously exhibited at CCMA.
2. At take-in, the artist must provide contact information and an inventory list showing title(s), medium, date created, and selling price, and must affix an ID tag showing the artist's name and the title of work to the front of the art. Forms are provided for this purpose.

2-dimensional art:

1. All two-dimensional art must be ready to hang and wired with properly installed D-rings. **No sawtooth hangers or eye screws are allowed.**
2. Art may not exceed 48" in any direction. Work framed and over 24" in either direction, must have plexiglass, not glass.

3-dimensional art:

1. Sculpture and ceramic art may not exceed 50 lbs. and must have appropriate bases for display on pedestals. (The Museum will supply pedestals.)
2. Relief sculptural or ceramic art must have a wire/hanging device/french cleat and should not exceed 20 lbs.

The Chaffey Community Museum of Art is located at 217 South Lemon Avenue, Ontario, and is open from 12 to 4 p.m., Thursday through Sunday. Admission is free.
