

Ray opened the demo with the usage of GOUACHE, an opaque watercolor paint similar to watercolor in that it can be rewetted and dried to a matte finish. It's quick coverage and total hiding power lends itself to more direct painting techniques than watercolor, as in 'plein air' paintings, posters, illustrations, and comics. Ray as mastered his methods and his floral paintings show it. "IPlam like a turtle, paint like a rabbit."


